Future2 shortlists grant applications; applauds FPA Chapter support

Future2 has reported an increase in the number and calibre of Make the Difference! Grant applications this year. By the closing date on 31 July, 21 applications had been received covering a wide spectrum of community based projects supporting the underprivileged, the homeless and those affected by poverty, and those impacted by drugs and other disadvantages.

Of the 21, six have been shortlisted by the Foundation's Grants Committee, which is now seeking further information from the charities and will make recommendations to trustees in October.

"We're particularly pleased with the way FPA Chapters have got behind Future2 in supporting the grant applications, resulting in this record number of applications", said Corinna Dieters, Chair of the Future2 Grants Committee and a former Chair of the FPA.
